



## OFFICIAL CALL

### 5<sup>th</sup> CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT REPUBLICAN ASSEMBLY AND CONVENTION SATURDAY, APRIL 4, 2020 - 12:30 P.M.

Pursuant to Article XI, Section 11.2 of the Bylaws of the 5<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Republican Central Committee and Colorado Revised Statutes § 1-4-102 and § 1-4-601, notice is hereby given that the 5<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Republican Assembly & Convention shall be convened beginning at 12:30 P.M. on Saturday, April 4, 2020 at Wasson High School at 2115 Afton Way, Colorado Springs, CO 80909. Check-in and credentialing for this Assembly and Convention will begin at 11:00 A.M.

A total of 684 delegates and 684 alternate delegates have been authorized by the Colorado Republican State Central Committee for this Assembly and Convention, which delegates and alternate delegates have been apportioned to each county according to the votes cast in each county for the Republican candidate for Governor in the last general election as described below.

The membership and proceedings of this Assembly and Convention shall be governed by the *Rules and Bylaws* of the 5<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Republican Central Committee, and by applicable provisions of the *Rules and Bylaws* of the Colorado State Republican Central Committee, and Colorado law.

The principal purposes of this Assembly and Convention of delegates shall be:

- To designate Republican candidate(s) for US House of Representatives from the 5<sup>th</sup> Congressional District on the 2020 Republican Primary Election ballot;
- To elect national delegates to attend the RNC 2020 Convention, and
- To consider and adopt such other rules and resolutions and conduct all other business of the Republican Party that may properly and lawfully come before such an Assembly and Convention of delegates.
