4th JUDICIAL DISTRICT REPUBLICAN ASSEMBLY AND CONVENTION SATURDAY, APRIL 4, 2020 - 9:30 A.M.

Pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes § 1-4-102 and § 1-4-601 and Article XIII of the Bylaws of the Republican State Central Committee and Article VII of the Bylaws of the Fourth Judicial District Republican Central Committee, notice is hereby given that the 4th Judicial District Republican Assembly shall be convened beginning at 9:30 A.M. on Saturday, April 4, 2020 at Wasson High School at 2115 Afton Way, Colorado Springs, CO 80909. Check-in and credentialing for this Assembly and Convention will begin at 8:30 A.M.

A total of 601 delegates and 601 alternate delegates have been authorized by the Colorado Republican State Central Committee for this Assembly and Convention, which delegates and alternate delegates have been apportioned to each county according to the votes cast in each county for the Republican candidate for Governor in the last general election as described below.

The membership and proceedings of this Assembly and Convention shall be governed by the *Rules and Bylaws* of the 4th Judicial District Republican Central Committee, and by applicable provisions of the *Rules and Bylaws* of the Colorado State Republican Central Committee, and Colorado law.

The principal purposes of this Assembly and Convention of delegates shall be:

- To designate Republican candidate(s) for District Attorney from the 4th Judicial District on the 2020 Republican Primary Election ballot; and
- To consider and adopt such other rules and resolutions and conduct all other business of the Republican Party that may properly and lawfully come before such an Assembly of delegates.

Pursuant to Section K of the Bylaws, a badge fee of \$2 per delegate and \$2 per alternate is set to cover the costs of the Assembly.

Candidates for District Attorney wishing to have their name printed on the ballot must notify the Chairman in writing no later than Saturday, March 21, 2020, at 2 p.m.
